

Those who know Jesus as Savior also love God and desire to keep His commandments!

¹Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and whoever loves the Father loves

the *child* born of Him. ² By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and observe His commandments. ³ For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments; and His commandments are not burdensome. ⁴ For whatever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world-- our faith. ⁵ Who is the one who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

⁶ This is the One who came by water [*Jesus' baptism*] and blood [*Jesus' crucifixion*], Jesus Christ; not with the water only, but with the water and with the blood. It is the Spirit [*who came down upon Jesus*] who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth. ⁷ For there are three that testify: ⁸ the Spirit and the water and the blood; and the three are in agreement.

Spoken in the upper room: Love one another!

L: The Holy Gospel according to St. John, the fifteenth chapter.

C: **Glory to You, O LORD.**

[*Jesus, to His disciples:*] ⁹ "Just as the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you; abide in My love. ¹⁰ If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love; just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love. ¹¹ These things I have spoken to you so that My joy may be in you, and *that* your joy may be made full."

¹² "This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you. ¹³ Greater

love has no one than this, that one lay down his life for his friends. ¹⁴ You are My friends if you do what I command you. ¹⁵ No longer do I call you slaves, for the slave does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you.”

¹⁶ “You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and *that* your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you. ¹⁷ This I command you, that you love one another.”

SERMON: God Wants Everyone to be Saved through Jesus! Acts 10:34-48 NAS-95

1. **Fear God and Do Right:** ³⁴ Opening his mouth, Peter said: “I most certainly understand *now* that God is not one to show partiality [treating one person better than another, like a Jew better than a Gentile], ³⁵ but in every nation the man who fears Him and does what is right is welcome to Him.
2. **Things Cornelius Heard about Jesus:** ³⁶ The word which [God] sent to the sons of Israel, preaching peace [forgiveness and reconciliation] through Jesus Christ (He is Lord of all)—³⁷ you yourselves know the thing which took place throughout all Judea, starting from Galilee, after the baptism which John proclaimed. ³⁸ You know of Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and *how* He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.”

3. **Peter’s Eyewitness Testimony:** ³⁹ “We are witnesses of all the things He did both in the land of the Jews and in Jerusalem. They also put Him to death by hanging Him on a cross. ⁴⁰ God raised Him up on the third day and granted that He become visible, ⁴¹ not to all the people, but to witnesses who were chosen beforehand by God, *that is*, to us who ate and drank with Him after He arose from the dead.
4. **Jesus’ Command to His Followers:** ⁴² And He ordered us to preach to the people, and solemnly [seriously] to testify that this is the One who has been appointed by God as Judge of the living and the dead. ⁴³ Of Him all the prophets bear witness that through His name everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins.” // Key things:
 - a. “Judge of the living and the dead”
 - b. “Of Him all the prophets bear witness”
 - c. “everyone who believes in Him...”
5. **Confirmation of God’s Love for Gentiles:** ⁴⁴ While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who were listening to the message. ⁴⁵ All the circumcised believers [Jews] who came with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also. ⁴⁶ For they were hearing them speaking with tongues and exalting God.
 - a. Why the Past Separation?
 - b. Why the Current Union?
6. **Baptism:** Then Peter answered, ⁴⁷ “Surely no one can refuse the water for these to be baptized who have received the Holy Spirit just as we *did*, can he?” ⁴⁸ And he ordered them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked him to stay on for a few days.

- L: The Lord be with you. *2 Tim. 4:22*
- C: **And also with you.**
- L: Lift up your hearts.
- C: **We lift them to the Lord.** *[Col. 3:1]*
- L: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
- C: **It is right to give Him thanks and praise.** *[Ps. 136]*
- L: It is truly good, right, and beneficial that we should at all times, and in all places, give thanks to You, holy Lord, almighty Father, everlasting God. And most especially are we bound to praise You during this Easter Season for the glorious resurrection of Your Son, Jesus Christ, the Ultimate Passover Lamb, who was sacrificed for us and bore the sins of

the world. By His dying He has destroyed death, and by His rising again He has restored to us everlasting life. Therefore with Mary Magdalene, Peter and John, and with all the witnesses of the resurrection, with angels, and with all the company of heaven we laud and magnify Your glorious name, evermore praising You and singing:
